
SENATOR STEVE DAINES TURNED HIS BACK on Montana Farmers and Ranchers

- Montana ranks 7th in the states with the number of beef cows at almost 1.5 million head and cattle ranked #1 in the state's cash receipts by commodity in 2017. 22.6 million pounds of red meat were produced in 2017. Source: beef2live.com, USDA/NASS
- Montana's 60 dairy farms are home to some 12,000 cows which produced 32 million gallons of milk in 2018, ranking the state 17th in milk output per cow.
